



Third Sunday of Lent $M_{ m ARCH~3,2024}$



Dear Friends in Christ,

Have you ever imagined the face of Jesus when he got angry? I am not kidding! Jesus did get angry when he saw the religious leaders using the Holy Temple for their personal gain or for making the Temple a "market place."

The gospel of the Third Sunday of Lent recounts how Jesus showed His "anger" toward those who misused His Father's House. Absolutely, His "anger" is justified. We never see, read or hear about Jesus expressing His "anger" like that. Of course, He gets upset with the Pharisees, the Scribes and other religious leaders, but He never "expressed" being upset through His actions. This time, however, His Father's House is so important that He could not hold His "anger" inside of Him anymore. This is telling us that His Father's House must be respected.

Heis Father's House is the House of Prayer, the Holy Place and God's dwelling place. It must be totally respected with reverence and love. The House of God or the Church building where we gather in Jesus' name to celebrate the Eucharist and other liturgical celebrations, has been consecrated for sacred activities. Therefore, the inside of the Church is not the place for socializing (talking or chit chat), particularly before and after Mass; the Church is not the place to gain "power, prestige, or any kind of benefit" for individuals.



Again, the Church, where we gather as God's children and as brothers and sisters to worship God, is the Holy Place because of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. If we do believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, we should show/express our true belief. Our body is also the Temple of the Holy Spirit. Does this Temple look like a "marketplace" now? Or is this really a holy temple for the Holy Spirit to dwell? If Jesus comes to our own temple (Body) now, does He need to "make a whip out of cords" to drive out "things" that made our temple filthy, obscene, dirty?

In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, let us give thanks to God because He does not "make a whip out of cords" to show us His "anger" because of our sins or because we misused the Temple of the Holy Spirit. Instead of doing it, He forgives our sins, no matter how "BIG" our sins are, and He will tell us: "Your sins are forgiven. Stand up, go home and sin no more." Do you want to hear these words again personally? Come to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Jesus is patiently waiting for you!
