CLOSER TO JESUS

Dear Friends in Christ,

“Abram put his faith in the Lord,” ... as we read in the first reading from the Second Sunday of Lent. What made Abram put his faith in the Lord? God told Abram to *“Look up at the sky and count the stars, if you can. Just so shall your descendants be.”* How many stars could Abram count or see during the daylight? Yet, Abram trusted the Lord’s words; Abram put his faith in the Lord.

How about you and me? Do we truly put our faith in the Lord, in what He promised, in what He said, in what He commanded? We always have the tendency of wanting to understand first before we accept the teachings of the Lord or His commands. We always want to know why we have to do this or to avoid that as the Lord taught and the Church teaches. We want to know how and when God’s promise will be done. We want to see things *“clearly”* before we believe. We want to *“touch”* lest we doubt (just as doubting Thomas).

We really lack faith! Our faith is really weak! Or we have no faith at all in God though we come to Church every Sunday and pray every day!

During Lent, let us spend more time with God through prayer and attending the Sacred Liturgy (Holy Mass, Reconciliation, the Stations of the Cross, meditation, adoring Jesus in the Eucharist on Fridays...). Examine our life of faith. What do we do to make our faith stronger? What do we do to nourish our faith? What should we do to strengthen our faith? What virtue should we try to achieve first?

Actually, we all have faith in God, but the degree of faith in God in each person is different. The strength of our faith is expressed through how we live our life according to the commands of God and His Church’s teachings

Hopefully, you and I will take advantage of this Holy Season of Lent to come, not just **closer** to God or love His Church more, but also **remain** in God’s love and **defend** His Church.

If our faith in God is mature and strong, we will keep that faith in God to the end, we are sure that we will not only witness *“The Transfiguration”* of the Lord Jesus Christ, but also be transfigured to be like Him. Actually, at every Holy Mass we, with the **“eye of faith,”** do witness *“The Transfiguration”* of the Lord on the Sacred Altar of God: bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Jesus our Lord: **The Transubstantiation.**

The glory of God appears in front of us at every Holy Mass, but do we see it and believe or we do not believe it at all. We are in the holy presence of God’s glory, so we should be awed and reverent and tremble, but what is the reality when we are in God’s presence? (I do not need to tell you again, do I?)

With faith, let us hear once again the voice from the cloud at the Transfiguration of the Lord Jesus: ***“This is my chosen Son; listen to him.”*** And Jesus told His Apostles: *who listens to you, listens to me* (The Chosen Son of the Father).
